Do you have **children** or other dependents?

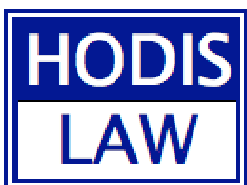
If you answer **yes** to any of these questions you should have a will & powers of attorney.
